Thanks for the interest you expressed in attending our next FJP convening in **Washington, DC on Friday, September 13th, 2024**, with a welcome dinner on Thursday evening, September 12th. This convening will focus on how data can enhance, enlighten and promote change in DA offices and the criminal legal system. Although the agenda is still in the planning stages, we expect to spend time on important and timely topics that will include, among others:

- Using data to drive culture change and internal office transformation and management;
- The role of data in understanding and addressing racial disparities;
- Data as a vehicle to engage and collaborate with the community; and
- Data as a driver for, and validator of, policy initiatives - with a focus on innovations and examples from around the network
