Dear Mr. Hasanali,

The Fort Bend Subsidence District (FBSB) was informed by Mr. Morris Mitchell, Director appointed by the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court, of his resignation effective August 20, 2024. The position held by Mr. Mitchell is defined by the FBSB statute as: appointed by Fort Bend County Commissioners Court and specifically representing business interests. This board position normally expires on January 31 of each odd year.

No additional action will be taken by the FBSB Board of Directors on this matter – although I expect that we will recognize Mr. Mitchell's many years of service to the Community as a Director at a subsequent Board of Directors meeting.

Appointments made to the FBSB board are two-years in length. In order to maintain the distribution of expiring board positions on this 17-member Board of Directors, please specify any appointment made to fill the now vacant position to continue through January 31, 2025 to serve the remaining time in this two-year term. A subsequent (re)appointment can then be made from January 31, 2025 – January 31, 2027.
