Honorable Judge George:

Fort Bend County Engineering Department has received and reviewed a request (letter attached) from Kaluza Inc., on behalf of Lamar Consolidated Independent School District for Fort Bend County to sponsor a project for two public road connections for Tiger Run Boulevard at FM 359. The road connections will provide access for the proposed LCISD Campus 8.
