

The IACME Annual Training Symposium is being held in-person with a virtual option from July 20-24, 2025, in Las Vegas, NV. The in-person Symposium will be held at the Golden Nugget Hotel.

There are two parallel in-person Symposium opportunities, the Core Concepts of Medicolegal Investigations Course and the Advanced Medicolegal Death Investigation Conference. Both courses will request Nevada POST, ABMDI, and AMA PRA Category 1 Credits.

- The Advanced Medicolegal Death Investigation Conference is designed to provide medicolegal professionals and those in positions relating to medicolegal death investigation an in depth view and study of more advanced concepts. Topics presented will provide attendees with a variety of comprehensive details in multiple areas of learning. These presentations will focus on advanced death investigative theories and introduce new and emerging trends. The Advanced Medicolegal Death Investigation Course will be held at the Golden Nugget in Las Vegas, NV, and with content streamed live to attendees via Zoom with interaction opportunities.
- The Core Concepts of Medicolegal Death Investigations is designed for medicolegal death investigators, and is intended to familiarize them with the operation of a medicolegal death investigation system, and the role of a medicolegal death investigator. Topics presented will provide a medicolegal investigator a solid foundation. The training provided will give the attendee the basic information and expertise required to conduct death scene investigations as a medicolegal death investigator. Topics will cover basic investigative components and provides advanced training for those already working in the field. The Core Concepts of Medicolegal Death Investigations Course is held in-person at the Golden Nugget Hotel in Las Vegas, without a virtual component.

In-person registration includes:

- Access to all in-person sessions and access to the Advanced Medicolegal Death Investigation Course for on-demand learning.
- One admission to the Sunday Night Welcome Reception and Exhibit Hall on July 20, 2025 (Guest tickets available for \$35/each).
- One admission to the Tuesday Night Pool-Side Networking Event on July 22, 2025 (Guest tickets available for \$35/each).

The **Monday Evening Mob Museum Networking Event** is held at the Mob Museum on July 21, 2025, from 6 PM to 10 PM with hors d'oeuvres at 7 PM and a cash bar available. Tickets are needed for every attendee, including those registered for the conference, with the tickets priced at \$55/each. The Mob Museum is within walking distance from the Golden Nugget, and transportation will not be provided.

A **Tour of the Clark County Coroner's Office** is scheduled for Wednesday, July 23, 2025, from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM. The tour is for registered attendees only and is free of charge. Participants will need to to arrange their own transportation to/from the Coroner's Office. The tour is capped at 25 people.

If you have already registered and would like to purchase additional tickets, you can use a different email address to not disturb your original conference registration purchase. There is no membership pricing for additional tickets or the Mob Museum, so you do not need to be logged into your account for the pricing.

Registration & Cancellations:

Early bird registration costs are \$450 for members and \$650 for non-members until April 1, 2025. After April 1, 2025, registration fees are \$550 for members and \$750 for non-members. All registration costs are in USD.

Additional guest tickets for the Sunday Night Welcome Reception and the Tuesday Night Pool-Side Reception are \$35/each and can be purchased during the registration process. Tickets for the Mob Museum on Monday night are not included in registration fees and are \$55/person.


Registration and add-ons are reimbursable, minus a \$15 processing fee, until May 1, 2025. Registration and add-on cancellations from May 2 to June 30, 2025, will be reimbursed at 50% of the registration fee. Registration and add-on cancellations on/after July 1, 2025, are not reimbursable.

Accommodations:

The Symposium is being held at the Golden Nugget Hotel in Las Vegas, NV. Rooms are available for as low as \$62 per night with a discounted resort fee of \$20/night (plus 13% tax).
