#### SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT ("Second Amendment"), is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and Taylor Construction Management, LLC (hereinafter "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas (collectively referred to as the "parties").

WHEREAS, the parties previously executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Construction Inspection Services on April 7, 2020, for the Fort Bend County Mobility Bond Program (the "Agreement"), and incorporated fully by reference for all purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was subsequently amended on July 25, 2023 (the "First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, by execution of this Second Amendment, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to provide for additional services by Contractor and increase the total Maximum Compensation for the completition of the additional services; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the foregoing, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

- 1. County shall pay Contractor an additional Four Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Twenty-Seven dollars and 04/100 (\$488,327.04) to perform the additional Services as described in Contractor's Proposal, dated March 1, 2025, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- 2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for all Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed One Million Four Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Four dollars and 64/100 (\$1,448,354.64), authorized as follows:

\$513,456.00 under the Agreement;

\$446,571.60 under the First Amendment; and

\$488,327.04 under this Second Amendment.

- 3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and this Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without an agreement executed by the parties.
- 4. The contents of this Section are required by Texas Law and are included by County regardless of content. For purposes of Sections 2252.152, 2271.002, and 2274.002, Texas Government Code, as amended, Contractor hereby verifies that Contractor and any parent company, wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, and affiliate:

- a. Unless affirmatively declared by the United States government to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan or Iran or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization, is not identified on a list prepared and maintained by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.
- b. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not boycott Israel and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott Israel during the term of such contracts. "Boycott Israel" has the meaning provided in § 808.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- c. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in § 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- d. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the meaning provided in § 2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. "Firearm entity" and "firearm trade association" have the meanings provided in § 2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged. If there is a conflict among documents that make up the Agreement, this Second Amendment shall prevail with regard to the conflict.

## **Position:** Construction Inspector

#### **Job Description:**

Construction Inspector will be responsible for daily on-site inspection of one or more transportation infrastructure projects to verify the contractor's conformance to the project documents. The inspector will report directly to the Field Engineer and/or Construction Manager assigned to the project.

Understanding of civil/roadway construction practices and procedures, coordination with private utilities, HOA's, businesses, property owners, and Fort Bend Staff/Consultants will be required throughout the projects.
