**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AMNEDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 19/89TH TEXAS LEGISLATIVE
SESSION**

WHEREAS House Bill 19 being considered in the 89th Texas Legislative Session will have a material impact on Fort Bend County by significantly delaying or preventing the ability of the County to address critical capital needs;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

This _____ day of May 2025, the Fort Bend Commissioners Court, meeting as a body in _____, Texas:

1. Supports amending House Bill 19 as follows:
 - a. Previously authorized debt should be excluded from the 20% limitation of annual debt service to average three-year property tax collections.
 - b. Existing debt through 8/31/2025 should be excluded from the 20% limitation of annual debt service to average three-year property tax collections.
 - c. Designated infrastructure should remain with the inclusion of: Equipment; Facility Renovations; Roads; Bridges; Drainage/Flood Mitigation; and Information Technology.
 - d. Existing non-voted debt through 8/31/2025 should be excluded from the impact of any change in the definition or elimination of designated infrastructure.
