APAC-BE Exam Offered - Separate Registration & Approval Required

<u>Please note that the APAC-BE exam is unaffiliated with our ADA Coordinator Training Certification Program (ACTCP) and is a completely separate exam.</u>

The Great Plains ADA Center is excited to once again collaborate with the Accessibility Professionals Association (APA) Certification Program. The APA Certification Exam in the Built Environment (APAC-BE), the only national certification exam for accessibility in the built environment, will be offered at the National ADA Symposium. This

joint initiative signifies our commitment to advancing the professional growth and recognition of individuals within the accessibility industry.

The written exam will be offered during the Symposium on Tuesday, June 17th, from 6:00 PM - 10:00 PM. ADA Symposium attendees applying to take the exam at the Symposium will receive 50% off the testing fee (a \$55 value), plus the application fee (\$500 for APA members and \$750 for non-members). Your application must be approved BEFORE you can sit for the exam. The application deadline is Friday, May 30th, and seating is limited. To apply, visit
