ORDER IMPOSING SALES AND USE TAXES WITHIN EXPANDED AREAS OF THE
BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2025, Fort Bend County Commissioners Court (“Court”) held an election in an area of Fort Bend County (“County”) that is not located within the boundaries of Fort Bend County Assistance District No. 4 (“District”) to determine whether the area should be included in the District and whether the District’s sales and use tax should be imposed in the area; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2025, the County certified the results of the election held in the area, in which the majority of the votes received favored inclusion in the District and imposition of the sales and use tax in the area;

WHEREAS, Chapter 387 of the Texas Local Government Code permits the District to impose the sales and use taxes to finance the operations of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. The matters and facts set out in the preamble of this order are hereby found and declared to be true and complete and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The sales and use tax of one percent currently imposed within the boundaries of the District shall be imposed within the expanded areas of the District, in order to finance the operations of the District or for any other purposes authorized by law, commencing on the first day of the first calendar quarter occurring after the Texas State Comptroller receives this Order.

Section 3. This Order is effective immediately upon passage.
