FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and LJA Engineering, Inc. (hereinafter "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the County and McDonough Engineering Corporation executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on May 4, 2021 pursuant to SOQ 14-025, which was subsequently amended on March 8, 2022 (hereinafter the "First Amendment"), and January 23, 2024 (hereinafter the "Second Amendment"; and

WHEREAS, McDonough Engineering Corporation and Contractor executed and accepted that certain Assignment and Assumption of Professional Services Agreement on July 26, 2024 (hereinafter the "Third Amendment"), to which the County consented to on December 18, 2024, (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Agreement"), attached hereto as Exhibit "A-2" and incorporated herein for all purposes; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to allow Contractor to provide additional Services under the Agreement and increase the total maximum compensation amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

- County shall pay Contractor an additional amount not to exceed twenty-seven thousand six hundred eighty dollars and 00/100 (\$27,680.00) to perform the additional Services, as described in Contractor's proposal dated March 24, 2025, attached hereto as Exhibit "B-2" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for all Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed eight hundred eighty-three thousand seven hundred fifteen dollars and 80/100 (\$883,715.80), authorized as follows:

- \$ 579,445.00 under the Agreement;
- \$ 52,836.00 under the First Amendment;
- \$ 223,754.80 under the Second Amendment;
- \$ 0.00 under the Third Amendment; and
- \$ 27,680.00 under this Fourth Amendment.
- 3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and this Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without an agreement executed by the parties.
- 4. Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts. The contents of this Section are required by Texas law and are included by County regardless of content For purposes of Sections 2252.152, 2271.002, and 2274.002, Texas Government Code, as amended, RPS hereby verifies that RPS and any parent company, wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, and affiliate:
- A. Unless affirmatively declared by the United States government to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan or Iran or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization, is not identified on a list prepared and maintained by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.
- B. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, RPS does not boycott Israel and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott Israel during the term of such contracts. "Boycott Israel" has the meaning provided in § 808.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- C. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, RPS does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in § 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- D. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, RPS does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the meaning provided in § 2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. "Firearm entity" and "firearm trade association" have the meanings provided in § 2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.

- 5. BY ACCEPTANCE OF AGREEMENT, CONTRACTOR ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.
- 6. Modifications and Conflict. Except as modified herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. If there is a conflict among documents that make up the Agreement, this Amendment shall prevail with regard to the conflict.



LJA's scope for the 7,800 LF road included the preliminary phase and final design phase engineering services to develop the project PS&E package for the construction of a 2-lane asphalt road with shoulders, roadside ditches and detention basin.

CIVIL SERVICES CONSTRUCTION PHASE

LJA will review contractor submittals and respond to RFIs. Fields visits and progress meetings will not be attended unless requested by Fort Bend County (FBC). LJA will coordinate with the County and County's staff as well as the contractor. LJA will attend a substantial completion walkthrough meeting, prepare record documents based on the contractor redlines and provide digital orhard copies to Fort Bend County. LJA has exhausted the unused funds from Amendment 2 Option 2 and Option 3 that were utilized on the updated survey of the existing basin, setting control for the contractor, updated cut and fill numbers due to revised detention basin conditions, revised drawings for driveway location, revised TCP per FBC request, and construction phase services.
