We, Forestar (USA) Real Estate Group INC., a Delaware Corporation, acting by and through Juanita Orsak, Division President — Houston South, owners of the 26.80 acre tract described in the above and foregoing map of AUGUST TRAILS SECTION 1, do hereby make and establish said subdivision and development plat of said property according to all lines, dedications, restrictions and notations on said maps or plat and hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever, all streets (except those streets designated as private streets), alleys, parks, water courses, drains, easements and public places shown thereon for the purposes and considerations therein expressed; and do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend the title to the land so dedicated

FURTHER, We have dedicated and by these presents do dedicate to the use of the public for public utility purpose forever unobstructed aerial easements. The aerial easements shall extend horizontally an additional eleven feet, six inches (11' 6") for ten feet (10' 0") perimeter ground easements or seven feet, six inches (7' 6") for fourteen feet (14' 0") perimeter ground easements or five feet, six inches (5' 6") for sixteen feet (16' 0") perimeter ground easements, from a plane sixteen feet (16' 0") above the ground level upward, located adjacent to and adjoining said public utility easements that are designated with aerial easements (U.E. & A.E.) as indicated and depicted hereon, whereby the aerial easement totals twenty one feet, six inches (21' 6") in width.

FURTHER, We have dedicated and by these presents do dedicate to the use of the public for public utility purposes forever unobstructed aerial easements. The aerial easements shall extend horizontally an additional ten feet (10' 0") for ten feet (10' 0") back-to-back ground easements or eight feet (8' 0") for fourteen feet (14' 0") back-to-back ground easements or seven feet (7' 0") for sixteen feet (16' 0") back-to-back ground easements, from a plane sixteen feet (16' 0") above ground level upward, located adjacent to both sides and adjoining said public utility easements that are designated with aerial easements (U.E. & A.E.) as indicated and depicted hereon, whereby the aerial easement totals thirty feet (30' 0") in width.

FURTHER, I (or we) do hereby declare that all parcels of land designated as lots on this plat are intended for the construction of single family residential dwellings units thereon (or the placement of mobile homes) and shall be restricted for same under the terms and conditions of such restrictions filed separately.

FURTHER, We do hereby covenant and agree that all of the property within the boundaries of this plat shall be restricted to prevent the drainage of any septic tanks into any public or private street, road or alley or any drainage ditch, either directly or indirectly.

FURTHER, We do hereby dedicate to the public a strip of land twenty (20) feet wide on each side of the center line of any and all bayous, creeks, gullies, ravines, draws and drainage ditches located in said subdivision, as easements for drainage purposes. Fort Bend County or any other governmental agency shall have the right to enter upon said easement at any and all times for the purposes of construction and maintenance of drainage facilities and structures.

FURTHER, We do hereby covenant and agree that all of the property within the boundaries of this subdivision and adjacent to any drainage easement, ditch, gully, creek or natural drainage way shall hereby be restricted to keep such drainage ways and easements clear of fences, buildings, excessive vegetation and other obstructions to the operations and maintenance of the drainage facility and that such abutting property shall not be permitted to drain directly into this easement except by means of an approved drainage structure.

FURTHER, We do hereby certify that we are the owners of all property immediately adjacent to the boundaries of the above and foregoing subdivision of AUGUST TRAILS SECTION 1 where building setback lines or public utility easements are to be established outside the boundaries of the above and foregoing subdivision and do hereby make and establish all building setback lines and dedicate to the use of the public, all public utility easements shown in said adjacent acreage.

FURTHER, We do hereby acknowledge the receipt of the "Orders for Regulation of Outdoor Lighting in the Unincorporated Areas of Fort Bend County, Texas", and do hereby covenant and agree and shall comply with this order as adopted by Fort Bend County Commissioners Court on March 23, 2004, and any subsequent

- 8. Site plans shall be submitted to Fort Bend County and any other applicable jurisdiction for review and approval to obtain a Development Permit. Development Permits and all other applicable permits shall be obtained from Fort Bend County prior to beginning construction.
- 9. This plat was prepared from information furnished by Texas American Title, Certificate No. 2791024-07533 CPL, effective date April 22, 2025. The surveyor has not abstracted the above property.
- 10. Five-eights inch (5/8") iron rods three feet (3') in length are set on all perimeter boundary corners, all angle points, all points of curvature and tangency, and all block corners, unless otherwise
- 11. All property to drain into the drainage easement only through an approved drainage structure.
- 12. All drainage easements to be kept clear of fences, buildings, vegetation, and other obstructions to the operation and maintenance of the drainage facility.
- 13. The drainage system for this subdivision is designed in accordance with the Fort Bend County Drainage Criteria Manual which allows street ponding with intense rainfall events.
- 14. Sidewalks shall be built or caused to be built not less that 5 feet in width on both sides of all dedicated rights-of-way within said plat and on the contiguous right-of-way of all perimeter roads surrounding said plat, in accordance with A.D.A.
- 15. The top of all floor slabs shall be a minimum of 86.50 feet above mean sea level. However, the minimum slab elevation shall be elevated to or above a height which is the higher of twenty-four (24) inches above the lowest adjacent top of curb, or in the absence of a curb, twenty-four (24) inches above highest natural ground along the perimeter of the building foundation, or twelve (12) inches above the down gradient roadway or any down gradient drainage restraint.
- 16. This property lies within Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 242, Fort Bend County Drainage District, Needville I.S.D., CAD 20, Wharton Junior College, Fort Bend ESD9, and Fort Bend County
- One-foot reserve dedicated to the public in fee as a buffer separation between the side or end of streets where such streets abut adjacent property, the condition of such dedication being that when the adjacent property is subdivided or re-subdivided in a recorded subdivision plat, the one-foot reserve shall thereupon become vested in the public for street right-of-way purposes and the fee title thereto shall revert to and revest in the dedicator, his heirs, assigns, or successors.
