ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, AMENDING THE REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULE TO COMPLY WITH HOUSE BILL 1522, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2025

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas ("Commissioners Court") is the governing body of the County and is required to comply with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, C.S.H.B. 1522 amends the Government Code to change the minimum required posting duration for a meeting notice from 72 hours to three business days before the scheduled date of the meeting; and

WHEREAS, Commissioners Court has determined that it is prudent to change the day of its regular meetings from Tuesday to Thursday to ensure compliance with the new posting requirement; and

WHEREAS, in an abundance of caution and to ensure full compliance with the amended law, the Commissioners Court intends to be proactive in its approach to meeting the new posting requirement and has accordingly determined that the notice for a regular Thursday meeting must be posted no later than 5:00 p.m. on the preceding Friday.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That the regular meeting day of the Commissioners Court shall be changed to Thursdays at 10:00 a.m., beginning with the first meeting held on October 9, 2025.
- 2. That the posting deadline for Commissioners Court agendas shall be no later than 5:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding a regular Thursday meeting, effective on October 9, 2025.
- 3. That County staff are directed to update all internal procedures, public notices, and the County website to reflect this new regular meeting and posting schedule.; and

4. That any Rule or Procedure pertaining to the Commissioners Court under Texas Government Code 551.007 and/or 551.023 shall be enforceable only after it has been formally adopted or amended by the court during a regularly scheduled meeting and will take effect at the beginning of the next regularly scheduled meeting.
