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**PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
MASTER GRANT AGREEMENT
AMENDMENT # 2**

THIS AMENDMENT is made by and between the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, called the "State" and Fort Bend County, called the "Subrecipient".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State and the Subrecipient executed a Master Grant Agreement on Jul 16 2021 4:28PM; and

WHEREAS, federal regulations and guidance have been updated ;

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend that Master Grant Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the State and the Subrecipient do agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

1. Description of Amended Items

ARTICLE 24. DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

Section 1. Requirements is replaced in its entirety with the following:

1. Requirements. The Subrecipient shall comply with Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements found within 49 CFR Part 26, and as amended by the Interim Final Rule (IFR) published in the Federal Register, Volume 90, No 190, October 3rd, 2025, with clarification provided in the IFR Frequently Asked Questions published October 24th, 2025.

Section 2 DBE Commitments, is replaced in its entirety with the following:

2. DBE Commitments. The Subrecipient shall, to the maximum extent feasible, achieve DBE commitments and attainment using DBE-neutral means. If it is determined, either through actual or projected overall DBE attainment, that PTN may not achieve the annual FTA overall DBE goal, then PTN, at its discretion, may require DBE-conscious means to ensure the annual FTA overall DBE goal is met. DBE-conscious means may include, but not be limited to, the inclusion of contract specific goals within Project Grant Agreements. PTN shall have final decision-making authority regarding the establishment of sub-recipient contract specific goals. The subrecipient will cooperate with the state in reporting DBE commitments, attainment, and good faith efforts made in the manner prescribed by the state.

2. **Incorporation of Master Grant Agreement (MGA) Provisions**

This amendment incorporates all the governing provisions of the MGA that are still in effect on the date of final execution of this amendment, unless an exception has been made by the terms of this MGA.

3. **Signatory Warranty**

Each signatory warrants that the signatory has necessary authority to execute this agreement on behalf of the entity represented.
