

3. **Compensation and Payment.** Contractor's fees shall be calculated at the rates set forth in the attached Exhibit A.
4. **Time of Performance.** The Agreement shall be effective upon execution by the last to sign of parties. The time for performance under this Agreement shall begin with receipt of the Notice to Proceed, which the County will promptly deliver to Contractor following the Agreement's effectiveness, and end no later than twenty-four (24) calendar months thereafter. Contractor shall provide the specified products and/or services to County as described in the Invoice, within this time or within such additional time as may be extended by the County.
5. **Taxes.** County is a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas and claims exemption from sales and use taxes. A copy of a tax-exempt certificate will be furnished upon request.
6. **Modifications and Waivers.** The Parties may not amend or waive this Agreement, except by a written agreement executed by both parties. No failure or delay in exercising any right or remedy or requiring the satisfaction of any condition under this Agreement, and no course of dealing between the Parties, operates as a waiver or estoppel of any right, remedy, or condition. The rights and remedies of the Parties set forth in this Agreement are not exclusive of, but are cumulative to, any rights or remedies now or subsequently existing at law, in equity, or by statute. No other provisions to this Agreement apply except for the terms which appear and/or are incorporated in this Agreement.
7. **Arbitration.** County does not agree to submit disputes arising out of the Agreement to binding arbitration. Therefore, any references to binding arbitration or the waiver of a right to litigate a dispute are hereby deleted.
8. **Human Trafficking.** BY ACCEPTANCE OF CONTRACT, CONTRACTOR ACKNOWLEDGES THAT FORT BEND COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.
9. **Conflict.** All terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified herein remains in full force and effect. In the event there is a conflict between this Agreement and the attached Exhibit(s), this Agreement controls to the extent of the conflict. In the event there is a conflict between this Agreement and DIR Contract No. DIR-TELE-CTSA-002, the DIR Contract shall control to the extent of the conflict.
10. **Understanding, Fair Construction.** By execution of this Agreement, the Parties acknowledge that they have read and understood each provision, term and obligation contained in this Agreement. This Agreement, although drawn by one party, shall be construed fairly and reasonably and not more strictly against the drafting party than the nondrafting party.

11. **Electronic and Digital Signatures.** The Parties to this Agreement agree that the electronic and/or digital signatures of the parties included in this Agreement are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as the use of manual signatures.
12. **Severability.** If any provision of this Addendum is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain in full force, if the essential terms and conditions of this Agreement for each party remain valid, binding, and enforceable.
