In no event shall the amount paid by County under this Agreement exceed the Maximum Compensation without a County approved change order. Project Manager clearly understands and agrees, such understanding and agreement being of the absolute essence of this Agreement, that County shall have available the total maximum sum of Two Million Seventy-Nine Thousand Seventy-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,079,075.00) specifically allocated to fully discharge any and all liabilities County may incur under the Agreement.

Project Manager does further understand and agree, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of the Agreement, that the total Maximum Compensation that Project Manager may become entitled to and the total maximum sum that County may become liable to pay to Project Manager under the Agreement shall not under any conditions, circumstances, or interpretations thereof exceed Two Million Seventy-Nine Thousand Seventy-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,079,075.00).

3. **Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts.** The contents of this Section are required by Texas law and are included by County regardless of content For purposes of Sections 2252.152, 2271.002, and 2274.002, Texas Government Code, as amended, Project Manager hereby verifies that Project Manager and any parent company, wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, and affiliate:

A. Unless affirmatively declared by the United States government to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan or Iran or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization, is not identified on a list prepared and maintained by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.

- B. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Project Manager does not boycott Israel and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott Israel during the term of such contracts. "Boycott Israel" has the meaning provided in § 808.001 of the Texas Government Code.
 - C. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Project Manager does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in § 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
 - D. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Project Manager does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the meaning provided in § 2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. "Firearm entity" and "firearm trade association" have the meanings provided in § 2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.
- 4. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of the Agreement.
 - 5. **Human Trafficking.** BY ACCEPTANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT, Project Manager ACKNOWLEDGES THAT FORT BEND COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.
 - 6. **Modifications and Conflict.** Except as modified herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and has not been otherwise modified or amended. If there is a conflict among documents that make up the Agreement, this Fourteenth Amendment shall prevail with regard to the conflict.





We would like to bring to your attention that our current projects, specifically the US 90A at SH 99 (13409) and the 13219x Lift Station at Packer Lane, remain active and are projected to extend beyond the original completion timeline through the end of 2025. Considering these project schedules and to ensure uninterrupted fulfillment of our contractual responsibilities, we respectfully request an extension of the 2013 Mobility Bond Program contract expiration date to **December 31, 2026**.


- The US 90A at SH 99 (13409) project continues to progress, with construction activities extending past the December 31, 2025, deadline. We are actively collaborating with the design consultant, and they currently estimate the project completion date to be July 30, 2026.
- The 13219x Lift Station at Packer Lane only remaining tasks now is the record drawings and then the project closeout. The record drawings should be completed by August 21st. We expect the project close out to be completed by December 31, 2026.
