## REGISTRATION PRICING

Beginning in this year, the New England Seminar on Forensic Sciences is updating how we set registration prices for The Maine Course. This change applies only to conference registration fees. It does not affect housing, room and board, meals, travel, or social events such as the lobster bake.

Under the new structure, registration pricing is based on whether an attendee is employer-funded or self-pay for their registration fee:

- Individuals whose employers or institutions will cover the full cost of their registration fee will register at the standard rate.
- Individuals who will pay any portion of their registration fee out of pocket, including those whose employers cover only part of the registration fee, are eligible for our tiered self-pay rates (which continue to vary for medical doctors, non-physicians, and students, as in prior years).

This policy was adopted to improve fairness, increase transparency, and stabilize conference pricing—especially for students and early-career professionals. As our non-physician and student participation has grown, we have become increasingly reliant on the higher medical-doctor registration fees to subsidize all other categories. The new

approach allows us to maintain affordable rates for those paying personally while ensuring that organizations that routinely budget for professional development contribute the full cost of attendance.

### REGISTRATION MODIFICATION AND REFUND POLICY

#### Registration Modifications

Non-cancellation modifications to registrations may be requested by emailing [info@nesifs.com](mailto:info@nesifs.com) no less than 20 days prior to The New England Seminar in Forensic Sciences. Where modifications decrease the total amount paid, the Registrant may be refunded no more than 75% of the original amount paid.

Modification requests made less than 20 days prior to the conference may not be permitted and will not be refunded.

#### Registration Cancellations

Registrants may cancel their registration by emailing [info@nesifs.com](mailto:info@nesifs.com). A fee of \$50/Registrant plus transaction fees will be withheld from all refunds.

Registrations canceled 60 days or more prior to the conference will be entitled to a refund of 100% of the original amount paid, less the cancellation fees.

Registrations canceled less than 60 days prior to the conference will be entitled to a refund of 75% of the original amount paid, less the cancellation fees.

Registrations canceled less than 20 days prior to the conference will not be refunded.

No refunds will be given for Registrants who do not cancel their registration, regardless of conference attendance.
