RE: Briarwood Crossing Drive at Learning Tree Lane in Briarwood Crossing Dr and Learning Tree Ln Ext STD – All-Way Stop Control

Dear Commissioner:

The Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed a review of the operational conditions at the intersection of Briarwood Crossing Drive at Learning Tree Lane in response to a request for all-way stop control. The intersection currently operates with stop control on Coopers Hill Trail. Both streets are identified as Local Streets in the 2015 Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan.

Per the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, in addition to vehicular volume a crash history, other factors that may be considered in evaluating an intersection for all-way stop control include the need to control vehicle/pedestrian conflicts near locations that generate high pedestrian volumes. Observations of the intersection during the morning arrival and afternoon dismissal periods for Culver Elementary School showed that vehicle/pedestrian conflicts were difficult for the crossing guard to control due to the heavy through volumes on Briarwood Crossing Drive.

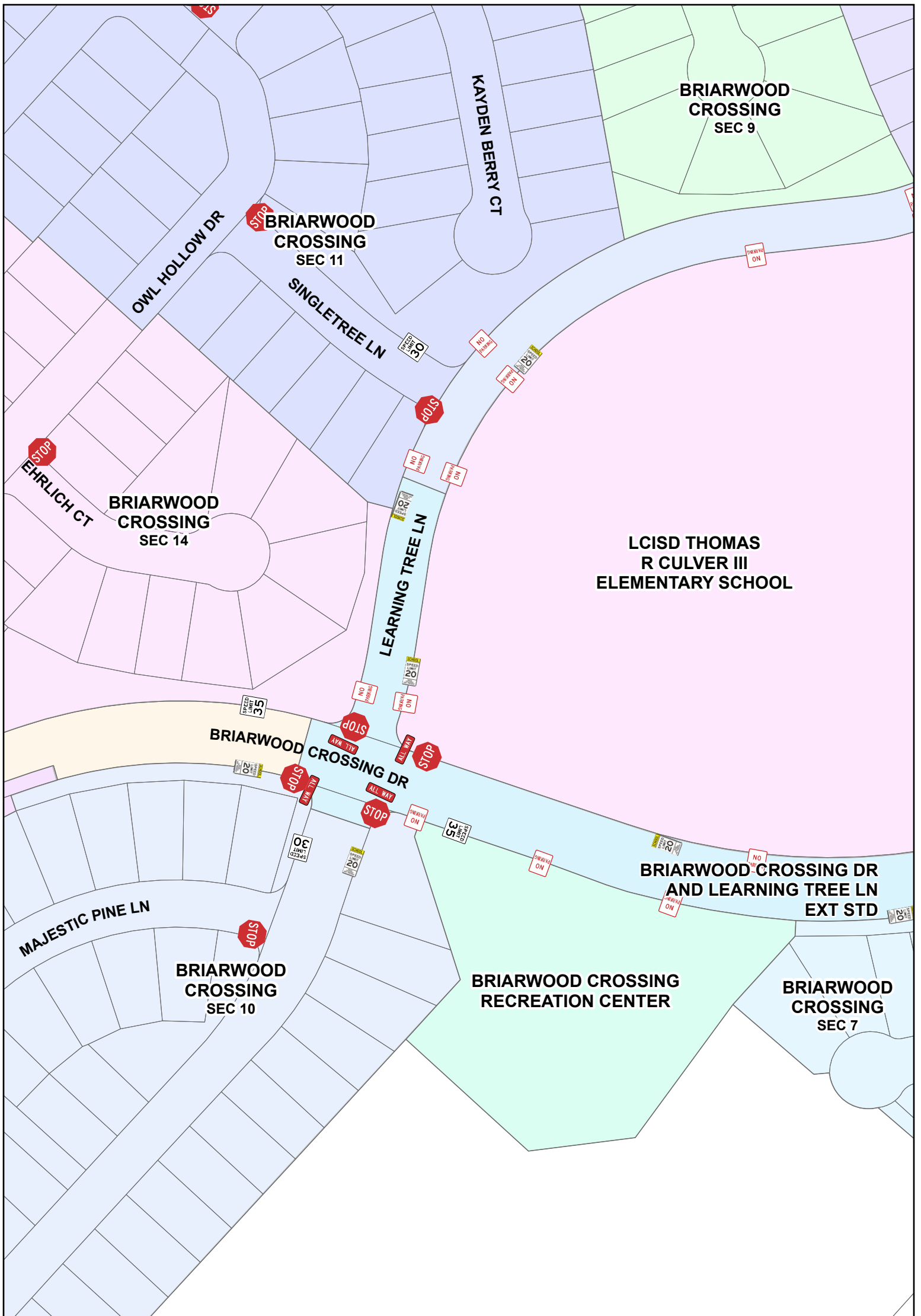
Due to these vehicle/pedestrian conflicts, an all-way stop is warranted and Engineering recommends the conversion of the intersection to all-way stop control. 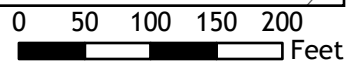
