Proclamation

- Whereas,* Texas hurricane season officially begins June 1st and ends November 30th, 2009, and;
- Whereas,* the State of Texas has historically experienced the damaging effects of hurricanes and severe inland weather systems spawned by hurricanes; and
- Whereas,* it is incumbent upon the Fort Bend County Office of Emergency Management in coordination with the state of Texas and local governments, as stewards of the public's safety, to inform and educate on appropriate hurricane preparedness safety measures, and;
- Whereas,* hurricanes can cause injury, loss of life and destruction of property and it is everyone's responsibility to know the proper action to take prior to a major storm.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Robert E. Hebert, County Judge of Fort Bend County, hereby proclaim May 25-31, 2009 as:

Hurricane Awareness Week

and encourage all citizens of the county to participate in hurricane preparedness activities, pay close attention to watch and warning instructions and assemble an emergency family preparedness kit.
