

Dear Patsy,

The Fort Bend Central Appraisal District has discovered that some of the properties located within the City of Missouri City TIRZ 2 (T106) were never coded to the district. The error was not discovered until March of 2008. The GIS department was verifying the boundary line for the TIRZ when the error was discovered.

The City of Missouri City TIRZ 2 was created in 1999 and some of the properties were coded with all active taxing entities with the exception of the TIRZ 2.

When the boundary for the district was created in 1999 it was with an older mapping system that was not capable of the technology that we have today which is the GIS system and the new Orion appraisal software. The original list of accounts to be coded to the TIRZ back in 1999 was a hand written list that was entered into our older appraisal software that was not capable of creating a table to add into our GIS system for an Analysis to assure all accounts were coded.

It was an error on our part that these accounts were left off.

Out of 766 accounts that are located within the TIRZ boundary, a total of 51 accounts were never coded for TIRZ 2.
