FIRST AMENDMENT TO TAX ABATEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN FORT BEND COUNTY and HE SUGAR LAND BUILDINGS, L.P.

This First Amendment of the Tax Abatement Agreement is made and entered into by and between FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, a body politic, acting herein by and through its Commissioners Court (hereinafter referred to as "County,") and HE SUGAR LAND BUILDINGS, L.P., (hereinafter referred to as "Owner"), each being parties to that certain Tax Abatement Agreement entered into by the parties on or about January 22, 2008, (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement.")

WHEREAS, Owner has requested to amend the completion date of the Improvments as stated in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, County and Owner desire to amend said Agreement as hereinafter set forth for the purposes described in this preamble;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived by the parties hereto, County and Owner agree as follows:

Pursuant to and in accordance with the Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act, Chapter 312, TEXAS TAX CODE, and the Guidelines and Criteria for Granting Tax Abatements in Reinvestment Zones located in Fort Bend County, Texas, the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

- Section 4(a) of the Agreement is amended as follows:
 "That construction of the Improvements shall be completed on or before January 1, 2011. Owner shall provide the Tax Assessor/Collector a certified statement evidencing a minimum of \$4,000,000 in project costs with respect to the design and construction of the Improvements."
- 2. The representative of Owner whose signature executes this First Amendment represents and warrants to County that he/she has the requisite authority to enter into this First Amendment
- 3. Except as modified herein, the above referenced Agreement remains in full force and effect and has not been modified or amended.

- 4. The tax abatement shall apply for the tax years as stated in the Agreement. This First Amendment does not purport to extend the tax abatement to tax years beyond tax year 2018, as stated in the Agreement.
- 5. All future amendments, if any, of the Agreement shall require written consent of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court.
- 6. The original Agreement executed by and between County and Owner on January 22, 2008, is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference the same as if fully set forth verbatim herein for all purposes, subject only to the above described amendments.
