PART I. INTRODUCTION

Texas Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone No. 4 (the Zone) encompasses approximately 700 acres within the City of Sugar Land, Texas. Located at the U.S. Highway 59 - University Boulevard interchange, the Zone is wholly within Fort Bend County and Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 17. Portions of the Zone are located within Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No.'s 137, 138 and 139.

The boundaries of the Zone are reflected in Fig. 1, below.

The Zone is created for a term of thirty (30) years pursuant to Sections 311.005(a)(1) and (2) Texas Tax Code (the Act). The Zone is created for the purpose of financing public improvements and facilities necessary to support development of employment, commercial, cultural arts, sports and entertainment districts within an urban-density mixed use center.
