## Sample Overtime Reimbursement for Clinical Health Services staff

H1N1 Vaccination clinics with staff working over normally scheduled hours began November 30, 2009.

PHER grant has contracted for 7 nurses and 5 clerical staff to support the vaccination effort through temporary agencies. However, some Clinical Health Services staff is working at each clinic to assist with the process, ensure security and correct storage of the vaccine and for translation purposes. Clinical Health Services cannot absorb the amount of compensatory time that would be accrued as this would impact future operations of the clinic for regular services.

The PHER grant can pay for the time that the CHS staff is pulled from their normal duties to work on the H1N1 vaccination efforts, but not for the overtime premium.

This agenda item requests permission to pay overtime to the CHS staffs who works these clinics, with the grant picking up all straight time.

## **Example:**

Nurse a works the following schedule

Monday: Regular CHS activity – 8 hours Tuesday: H1N1 vaccination clinic – 12 hours Wednesday: Regular CHS activity – 8 hours Thursday: H1N1 vaccination clinic – 12 hours

Friday: Regular CHS activity – 8 hours Saturday: H1N1 vaccination clinic – 4 hours

Equates to 24 hours of regular work 16 hours of regular time at H1N1 clinic 12 hours of over regular schedule time at H1N1 Clinic

Fort Bend County would pay 24 hours of Regular Pay PHER grant would pay 28 hours at Regular Pay Fort Bend County would pay 12 hours of overtime premium (= 12 x 0.5x hourly wage)
