FORT BEND COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

THE STATE OF TEXAS. COUNTY OF FORT BEND,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned: Dr. M.L. Friedrich 6046 Cheena Dr.

Houston, TX 77096-4710

whose address is as shown above (hereinafter called GRANTOR, whether one or more) for and in consideration of the benefits to be derived on account of and from the construction, operation and maintenance by Fort Bend County Drainage District, of the drainage canal and system upon and through the land hereafter described, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents hereby grants, bargains, sells and conveys unto said Fort Bend County Drainage District, a corporation (hereinafter called the DIS-TRICT), of Fort Bend County, Texas, a right of way and easement for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating, repairing and re-constructing a drainage canal, including drains, ditches, laterals and levees, upon, over, through and across the land of GRANTOR along the route hereinafter designated, and said land being situated in Fort Bend County, Texas, to-wit:

The DISTRICT shall have an easement of an aggregate width of feet, extending at right angles, on each of the following line and cour cross said land. to-wit:

The District shall have an easement totaling 3.8458 acres which is connected to and shall lie south of an existing easement 80 feet in width previously recorded in Volume 323, on Page 245, of the Deed Records of Fort Bend County Texas, and more particularly described within the metes and bounds descriptions attached as Exhibit "A" and the standard land survey attached as Exhibit "B".

During channel construction and during channel maintenance operation, the District is authorized to spread spoil dirt and excavated material, operate machinery and do any necessary clearing, upon the premises of Grantor immediately adjoining the easement as above described.

The DISTRICT shall have all rights and benefits necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use of the rights herein granted, with the right of ingress and egress to and from said drainage canal right of way, provided, however, that after construction of said drainage canal, said right of ingress and egress of the DISTRICT shall be limited to the said right of way and to existing roads and passageways. The DISTRICT is given the right from time to time to cut and remove all trees, undergrowth, and abate other obstruction, upon said canal right of way, that may injure, endanger, or interfere with the construction, operation, maintenance and repair of said drainage canal.

The DISTRICT agrees during the life of this easement to repair all damage to roads, passageways and fences resulting from the DISTRICT'S use in going to and from said easement and right of way, and to restore the same to the previously existing condition as near as possible.

GRANTOR reserves the right to use the facilities offered by the drainage canal for the disposal of surface waters, rain, or any excess waters collecting upon his land, and in such connection GRANTOR has the right in the manner provided by law and at his own expense to construct and provide ditches, drains and laterals connecting his said land or portions thereof with the drainage canal.

GRANTOR reserves the oil, gas and sulphur in and under the land covered by this easement, provided however, that during the life of this easement no mining or drilling operations shall be conducted upon the surface of the area included in the easement right of way above described.

It is agreed that if at a future time the DISTRICT, its successors or assigns, shall permanently cease to use said drainage canal right of way for the purposes herein contained, and shall permanently abandon the same, then and in such event the said right of way above described, together with all rights and interests held by the DISTRICT by reason of this instrument, shall revert, pass to and vest in the said GRANTOR, his heirs or assigns.

Wickson League, Abstract No. 95, Fort Bend County, Texas; said 3.8458 acre tract being out of an 84.04 acre tract of land conveyed to Dr. M.L. Friedrich, et ux, as recorded in Volume 544, Page 248 of the Fort Bend County Deed Records; said tract being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows with the bearings being based on the Texas State Plane Coordinate System, South Central Zone using National Geodetic Survey Continuously Operating Reference Stations:

- 4.) In a westerly direction with a curve to the left having a radius of 1,500.00 feet, a central angle of 12° 18′ 54″, a length of 322.41 feet and a chord bearing North 86° 38′ 02″ West 321.79 feet to a point-of-tangency;
 - 5.) South 87° 12' 31" West 53.68 feet;
- 6.) In a westerly direction with a curve to the right having a radius of 340.00 feet, a central angle of 22° 37′ 12″, a length of 134.23 feet and a chord bearing South 81° 07′ 04″ West 133.36 feet to a point-of-tangency;
 - 7.) North 87° 34' 20" West 81.42 feet to a point-of-curvature;
- 8.) In a northwesterly direction with a curve to the right having a radius of 405.00 feet, a central angle of 54° 26′ 52″, a length of 384.87 feet and a chord bearing North 60° 20′ 54″ West 370.55 feet to a point-of-tangency;
- 9.) North 33° 07' 28" West 8.24 feet to a point for the west corner of this tract; said point having the following coordinates: X=2998103.78, Y=13732573.29;

THENCE, North 42° 31' 51" East - 26.10 feet with the northwest line of said 84.04 acre tract and with the southeast line of a tract of land conveyed to Calvin Eugene Lubojacky, as recorded in Fort Bend County Clerk's File No. 1999047723;

THENCE, the following six calls with the south and southeast lines of an 80 foot wide drainage easement, as recorded in Volume 323, Page 245 of the Fort Bend County Deed Records:

- 1.) In a southeasterly direction with a curve to the left having a radius of 380.00 feet, a central angle of 56° 40' 00", a length of 375.83 feet and a chord bearing South 59° 14' 21" East 360.70 feet to a point-of-tangency;
 - 2.) South 87° 34' 20" East 76.33 feet;
 - 3.) North 87° 26' 38" East 71.17 feet;
 - 4.) North 67° 45' 49" East 121.72 feet to a point-of-curvature;
- 5.) In a northeasterly direction with a curve to the left having a radius of 255.00 feet, a central angle of 87° 54' 03", a length of 391.21 feet and a chord bearing North 23° 48' 47" East 353.96 feet;
 - 6.) North 20° 08' 14" West 16.86 feet to a point for a northwest corner of this tract;

THENCE; In an easterly direction with a non-tangent curve to the right having a radius of 1,890.00 feet, a central angle of 07° 14' 07", a length of 238.67 feet and a chord bearing South 84° 36' 39" East - 238.51 feet to a point for a northeast corner of this tract;

THENCE, the following eight calls with the southwest and south lines of an 80 foot wide drainage easement, as recorded in Volume 323, Page 245 of the Fort Bend County Deed Records:

- 3.) South 15° 21' 50" East 205.74 feet;
- 4.) South 24° 48' 18" East 63.84 feet to a point-of-curvature;
- 5.) In a southeasterly direction with a curve to the left having a radius of 117.00 feet, a central angle of 74° 29' 51", a length of 152.13 feet and a chord bearing South 62° 03' 13" East 141.63 feet to a point-of-tangency;
 - 6.) North 80° 41' 51" East 108.43 feet;
 - 7.) North 62° 07' 44" East 315.39 feet;
 - 8.) North 58° 21' 42" East 2.65 feet to a point for a northeast corner of this tract;

THENCE, South 43° 12' 11" West - 123.86 feet with the southeast line of said 84.04 acre tract and with the northwest line of said 91.09 tract to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 3.8458 acres (167,522 square feet) of land.


