Congratulations! We are pleased to confirm that the Texas Historical Commission voted to award a planning grant for the Fort Bend County Courthouse in the amount of \$271,047 which we have calculated to be approximately two thirds of the total planning project cost. We appreciate all the hard work that went into your application. The competition for grants in Round VI of the Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program was strong. Of the 44 applicants from across the state, the commissioners voted to approve funding for 20 projects at this time.

Our experience has shown that in order to become familiar with the planning grant administration process, an orientation meeting is required and beneficial for the project's county representatives and professional consultants.
