The district has five commissioners and operates under HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE TITLE 9. SAFETY, SUBTITLE B. EMERGENCIES, CHAPTER 775. EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICTS.

Voters approved the creation of the district in May of 2007. August 28th, 2007 the County Commissioners of precinct 3 and 4 appointed five commissioners. The commissioners meet at 6:30 P.M., the second Tuesday each month, at the North East Fire Department located at 14007 Old Richmond Road, Sugar Land, Texas 77498

The district contracts Fire and Rescue services from the Northeast Fort Bend County Fire Department. The fire department has provided excellent service for over (38) thirty-eight years. The year 2009 is the first full year the fire department operated entirely under district funding.

2009 District Financial Condition

The district's budget for 2008 was approximately \$561,000.00. The 2009 budget was \$1,178,085.82 based on a tax rate .08 per \$100.00 property value. The budget for 2009 allowed the fire department to make much needed changes. At the end of the year, the fire department had a surplus of \$31,628 00.

The Fire Chief became a full time, paid position Personnel was increased to allow (24) hour staffing with a 3-man crew. Pay for the day crew increased for the first in ten years.

A new squad truck was purchased to run medical calls. An emergency power generator was installed to run the entire station. An order for a new pumper was placed to replace the current (10) ten year old pumper. Two (2) new semi-automatic external defibrillators were purchased. A new thermal imaging camera was purchased. Traffic signal priority control systems for (6) six intersections were ordered with installation date in early 2010.

These changes were needed to serve the increased population and growth in the district.

Looking to the future, the fire station is planning to build another station on the west side of the district, increase the crew to (4) men, twenty-four hours a day, and provide health insurance for the personnel.


