
I have received complaints from Dickinson Elementary regarding inadequate sight distance for parents exiting the student drop-off/pick-up driveway because of parents parking on Greatwood Parkway between Sansbury Boulevard and the student drop-off/pick-up driveway. I asked Traffic Engineers, Inc. to observe arrival and dismissal and recommend improvements. The recommendations, which address additional issues observed by Traffic Engineers, Inc., are shown on the attached aerial and include:

- 1. Installation of "No Parking" signs on southbound Greatwood Parkway, between Sansbury Blvd. and the school driveway because of sight distance issues for parents exiting the school driveway caused by parents parked on Greatwood Parkway to walk their student to and from the school building. Installation of "No Parking" signs on southbound Greatwood Parkway, south of the school driveway. The inside southbound lane of Greatwood Parkway, south of the school driveway, was blocked at times because of vehicles u-turning at the median opening located south of the school driveway at the same time that vehicles were parked in the outside lane on Greatwood Parkway while the parents walked their student to or from the school building.
- 2. Installation of "No Parking" signs on northbound Greatwood Parkway, between Sansbury Blvd. and the median opening south of the school driveway because a few parents were observed parking on northbound Greatwood Parkway and walking their student to or from the school building.
- 3. Installation of "No Parking" signs on eastbound Sansbury Blvd. between Greatwood Parkway and the school driveway because a few parents were observed parking on eastbound Sansbury Blvd. and walking their student to or from the school building.
- 4. Installation of "No Parking" signs on westbound Sansbury Blvd. between Greatwood Parkway and Tara Plantation Drive because a few parents were observed parking on westbound Sansbury Blvd. and walking their student to or from the school building.
- 5. Installation of a "No U-Turn" sign on southbound Tara Plantation Drive at the median opening at Tara Boulevard and the school driveway. Parents were observed waiting in the median opening to U-turn and get in the queue of parent vehicles on northbound Tara Plantation Drive. They waited in the median opening until the queue was north of the school driveway. There is currently a "No U-Turn" sign on westbound Sansbury Blvd. at the Tara Plantation Drive median opening to prevent parents from U-turning to access the school driveway.

I would like to request that Fort Bend County install the signs recommended by Traffic Engineers, Inc. as shown on the attached figure.
