EXHIBIT B

ASSIGNMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "Assignor"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and City of Sugar Land (hereinafter "Assignee").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Assignor and netEOP, Inc. executed and accepted that certain netPlanner Software License Agreement and Contract for Services (hereinafter "Agreement") on March 30, 2010, attached hereto as Exhibit A, for a fully paid subscription for two (2) licenses to use netPlanner and its documentation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.b.i. of the Agreement, Assignor is expressly authorized to assign all of its rights and responsibilities related to one license to Assignee; and

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee have executed a Governor's Division of Emergency Management State Administrative Agency Homeland Security Grant Program Property Transfer Record Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes, for one (1) license;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

- A. Assignor assigns to Assignee all of Assignor's interest in one (1) license identified in the Agreement.
- B. Assignee assumes all responsibilities under the Agreement related to one (1) license identified in the Agreement including, but not limited to, payment of any and all technical support and maintenance fees and any and all hosting fees related to the license. Assignee is not responsible for the Year 1 fees identified in Section 2 of the Agreement for the first term of the Agreement.
- D. Assignee agrees to be bound by all terms of the Agreement with regards to the license and shall indemnify, defend, and hold Assignor harmless from any loss, attorney's fees, expenses, or claims resulting from Assignee's breach of the terms of the Agreement or the attached Governor's Division of Emergency Management State Administrative Agency Homeland Security Grant Program Property Transfer Record Agreement.
- E. Assignee agrees that all written notices, demands, and other papers or documents to be delivered to Assignee under the Assignment and/or the Agreement shall be delivered to 2700 Town Center Blvd. North, Sugar Land, TX 77479

 Attention: Patrick Hughes, Emergency Management Director, or such other place or places as Assignee may designate by written notice delivered to netEOP, Inc. The mayor does not need to sign. The Director of Emergency Management has the authority to execute agreements for \$1500 or more.
- F. Assignee acknowledges that Assignor's initial purchase of the licenses involved the use of Homeland Security Grant Program funds. As such, Assignee agrees to use the license

with enhanced capabilities for detecting, deterring, disrupting, preventing, and responding to potential threats of manmade, natural disasters and acts of terrorism as described in the federal program guidelines, specifically: planning, equipment, training and exercise needs.

- G. Assignee represents and warrants to Assignor that Assignee has the requisite authority to enter into the Agreement, the Governor's Division of Emergency Management State Administrative Agency Homeland Security Grant Program Property Transfer Record Agreement, and Assignment.
- H. Assignor and Assignee bind themselves and their successors, executors, administrators and assigns to the other party of this Assignment and to the successors, executors, administrators and assigns of the other party, in respect to all covenants of this Assignment.
