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## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY SANDBAGGING BETWEEN FORT BEND COUNTY AND FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17

This interlocal agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between the Fort Bend County, hereinafter referred to as "County" and Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 17, hereinafter referred to as the "District;" and

WHEREAS, the District has constructed a levee to provide flood protection to the land within its boundaries, and

WHEREAS, the District has a floodgate on this levee that crosses New Territory Boulevard in Fort Bend County; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 7 has constructed additional levee and drainage improvements making the floodgate unnecessary; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to remove the unnecessary floodgate; and

WHEREAS, in the event of emergency high water, the District may need additional protection from flooding at New Territory Boulevard where it crosses the District's levee; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to enter into an agreement with County for sandbagging at New Territory Boulevard in the event of emergency high water jeopardizing flooding in the District at New Territory Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of each party has duly authorized this Agreement and the parties desire to enter into this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this agreement is made pursuant to and under the provisions of Chapter 791, Texas Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, the District and the County mutually agree as follows:

1. In the event of a potential emergency situation in which high water may top the District's levee at New Territory Boulevard, County will provide the District with sandbagging services at such location, upon request, and subject to availability of County Road & Bridge personnel as determined solely by the Road & Bridge Commissioner.

- 2. The District shall provide ample notice to County in the event of a potential emergency situation in which sandbagging may be needed.
- 3. It is expressly understood and agreed that this agreement may be terminated by either party upon 30 days written notice.
- 4. It is expressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto that this agreement shall be effective upon final execution as indicated in the dates shown below each signature and shall run from year to year with automatic renewals on the anniversary date unless terminated pursuant to Section 3 above.
