

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF RURAL AFFAIRS
CONTRACT NO. DRS010047 FOR
CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY ENTITLEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

SECTION 1

The Texas Department of Rural Affairs, an agency of the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as "TDRA", and the County of Fort Bend, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", do hereby contract and agree to amend their original executed contract, as initially executed by the Executive Director of TDRA effective January 12, 2010 for the performance of disaster recovery activities.

SECTION 2

The parties hereto agree to amend the contract identified in Section 1 above by deleting in its entirety SECTION 4, CONTRACT AMOUNT, and replacing it with the following:

SECTION 4. CONTRACT AMOUNT

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Contract, the total of all payments and other obligations incurred by TDRA under this Contract shall not exceed the sum of One Million Fifty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$1,054,738) reflecting the total allocation of disaster recovery funds to Grantee.

SECTION 3

The parties hereto agree to amend the contract identified in Section 1 above by deleting in its entirety Exhibit B, the Budget, and replacing it with the Budget that is attached to this amendment as Exhibit B, and hereby made a part of the contract. Exhibit B consists of three (3) pages.

SECTION 4

The parties hereto agree that this amendment shall become effective on the date of signature of this amendment by TDRA.

SECTION 5

The parties hereto agree that all of the terms of the contract identified in Section 1 above shall remain in effect and shall continue to govern except to the extent that they conflict with the terms of this amendment.


SECTION 6
