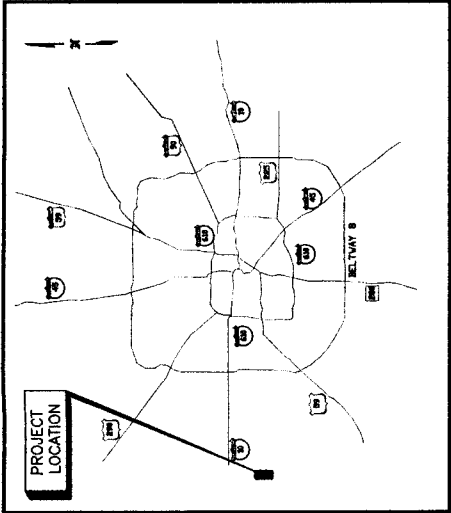

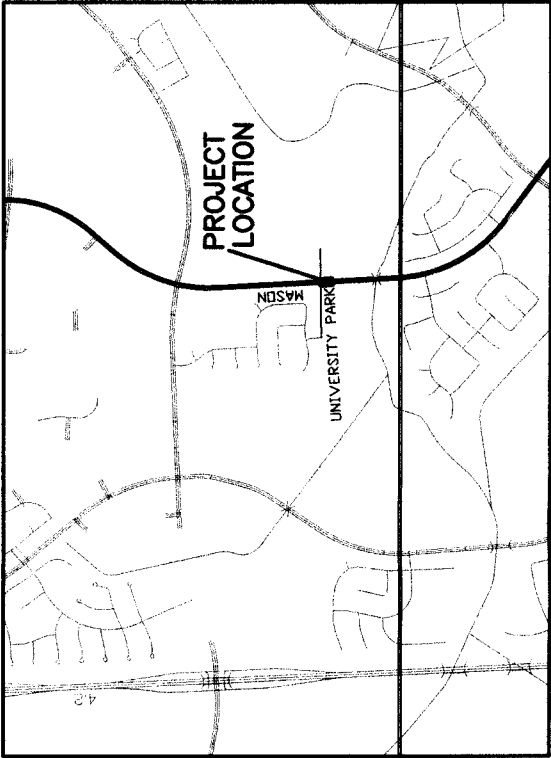
PROPOSED TELECOMMUNICATION CONDUIT

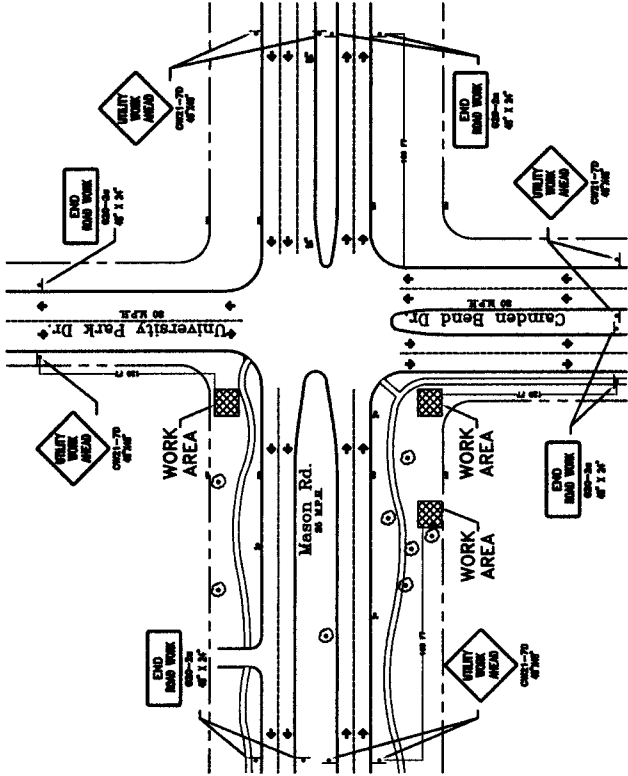

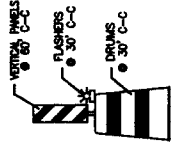
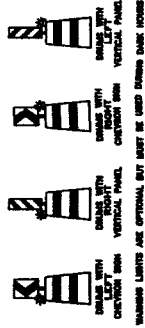

- 1 - CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND INSTALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN CONFORMANCE WITH PART VI OF THE TEXAS MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (TEXAS MUTCD), MOST RECENT EDITION WITH REVISIONS) DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- 2 - LANE CLOSURE PERMITS ARE TO BE OBTAINED (SEE NOTE 7).
 - a) NO LANES SHALL BE CLOSED DURING THE HOURS OF 5:30 AM TO 7:00 PM MONDAY THRU FRIDAY IN DOWNTOWN/AUTOTOWN AREA.
 - b) NO LANES SHALL BE CLOSED DURING THE HOURS OF 7:00 AM TO 8:00 AM AND 4:00 PM TO 6:00 PM MONDAY THRU FRIDAY ON MAJOR THOROUGHFARES.
 - c) NO LANES SHALL BE CLOSED ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS FROM 7:00 PM TO 7:00 AM.
- 3 - CONTRACTOR SHALL COVER OPEN EXCAVATIONS WITH STEEL PLATES ANCHORED PROPERLY DURING NON-WORKING HOUR AND OPEN LANES FOR NORMAL TRAFFIC FLOW.
- 4 - IF THE CONTRACTOR CHOOSES TO USE A DIFFERENT METHOD OF TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS DURING THE CONSTRUCTION THAN WHAT IS OUTLINED IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, HE/SHE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING THE NECESSARY PERMITS AND APPROVALS FROM THE CITY OF HOUSTON AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TxDOT) PRIOR TO IMPLEMENTATION.

- 7 - ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES USED AT NIGHT SHALL BE REFLECTORIZED OR ILLUMINATED.
- 8 - CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN LOCAL DRIVEWAY ACCESS TO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES ADJACENT TO WORK AREA AT ALL TIMES.
- 9 - CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY FIRE, POLICE, METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY, AND BUS SERVICES (3) WORKING DURING PRIOR TO IMPLEMENTATION FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL.
