
Dear Ms. Sowa:

Please advise if additional information is required.

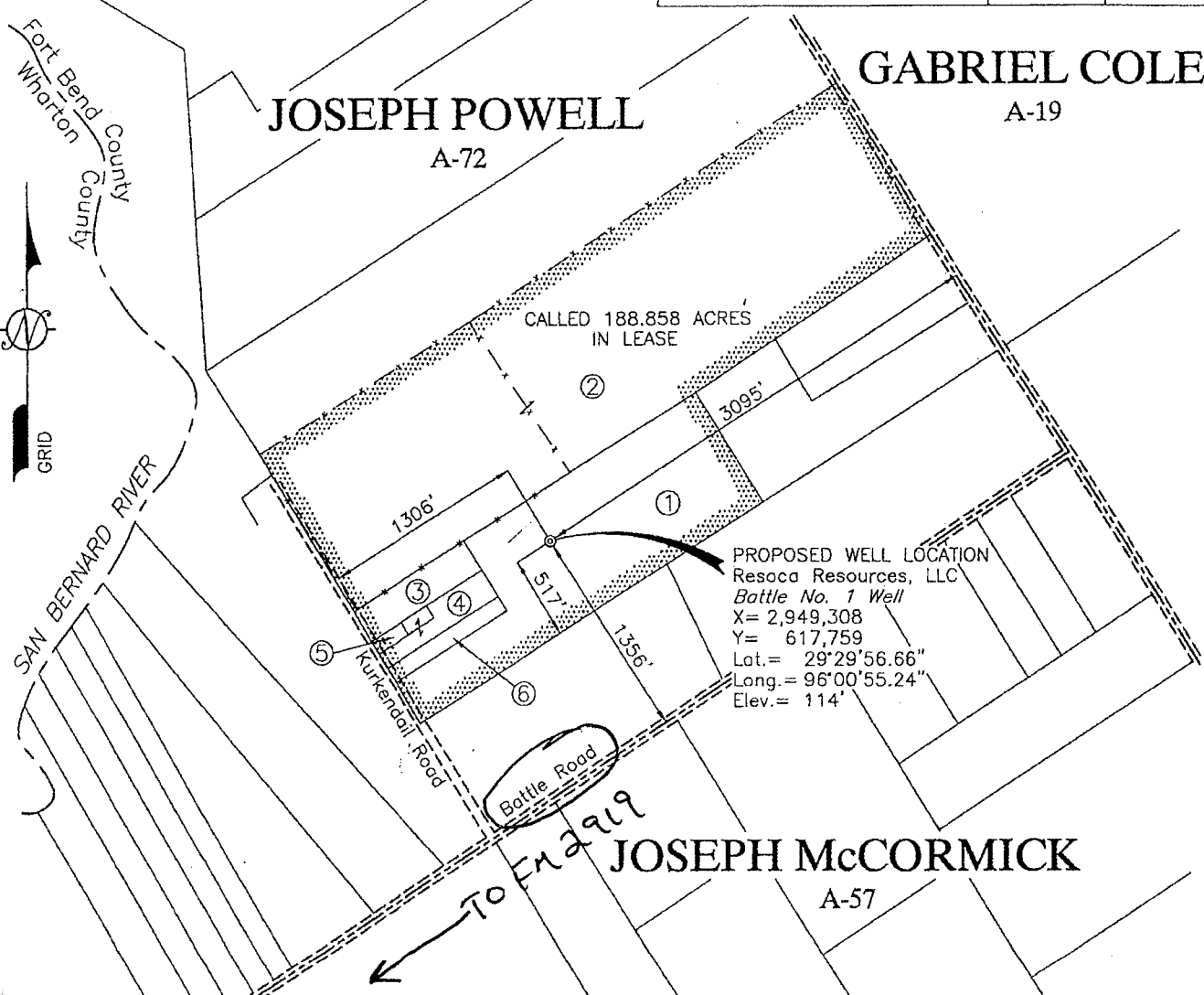

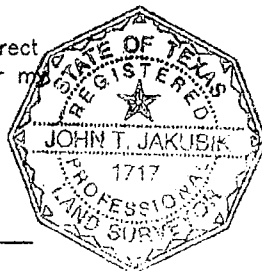
