SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

THIS SECOND AMDENDMENT is made and entered into by and between the Fort Bend County Drainage District, a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, acting herein by and through its Board of Directors, hereinafter referred to as "District," and Brown & Gay Engineers, Inc. hereinafter referred to as "Engineer," authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, District and Engineer entered an Agreement for Professional Engineering Services dated July 18, 2006, (collectively, the "Agreement") and a First Amendment on July 21, 2009, (collectively, the "First Amendment") attached hereto as Exhibit C & D, incorporated by reference as if set forth herein verbatim for all purposes. District and Engineer desire to amend said Agreement as set forth in Engineer's proposal dated February 18, 2011 and March 28, 2011, attached hereto as Exhibit A & B, and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth verbatim.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement between the District and Engineer is hereby amended to read:

- A. An additional amount not-to-exceed \$62,000.00 shall be available for additional services provided by Engineer in connection with the Project as described in Exhibit A & B.
- B. Engineer's compensation for the Project shall not exceed \$401,000.00, which includes the original scope of work in the amount of \$266,000.00 under the Agreement, additional services under the First Amendment in the amount of \$73,000.00 and the additional services described in Exhibit A.
- C. Reimbursable expenses shall be reimbursed to Engineer at-cost upon submission of properly submitted expense records to District as provided in the Agreement. Service charges are not applicable and not subject to reimbursement.
- D. No additional funding shall be available for services provided under the Agreement without prior written consent of the District.
- E. Except as modified herein, the Agreement and First Amendment remain in full force and effect and have not been modified or amended.
- F. If there is a conflict between this Second Amendment and the Agreement and First Amendment, the provisions of this Second Amendment shall prevail.


