## THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES PROJECT NO. 735 - MASON ROAD

- 1. Section 3.01 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:
  - "This Agreement shall become effective upon execution of the last party and shall terminate on or before December 31, 2012."
- 2. Except as modified herein, the Agreement, First Amendment and Second Amendment remains in full force and effect and has not been modified or amended.
- 3. If there is a conflict between this Second Amendment and the Agreement and prior amendments, the provisions of this Third Amendment shall prevail.
