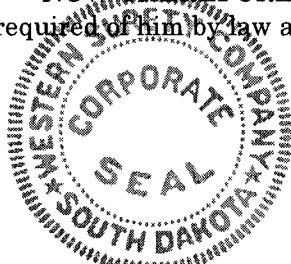

liability hereunder shall terminate as to subsequent acts of the Principal.

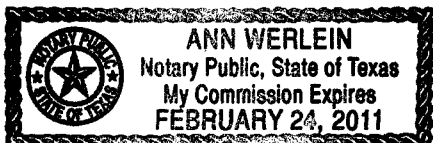

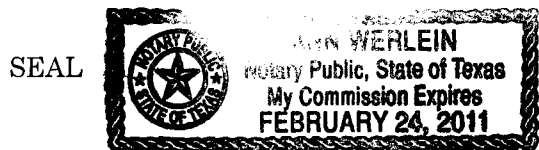
