Prior to the execution of this Amendment No. 2, Tiburon has been advised by County, and Tiburon clearly understands and agrees, such understanding and agreement being of the absolute essence to this Agreement, that County shall have available the total maximum sum of \$17,273.00, including all reimbursable expenses, if any, specifically allocated to fully discharge any and all liabilities which may be incurred by County for services provided under Exhibit A.
- 4. Tiburon does further understand and agree, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of this Agreement, that the total maximum compensation that Tiburon may become entitled to for services provide under Exhibit A and the total maximum sum that County shall become liable to pay to Tiburon hereunder for services provided under Exhibit A shall not under any conditions, circumstances or interpretations thereof exceed the sum of \$17,273.00.
- 5. Except as modified herein, the Agreement, Amendment No. 1 and Amendment No. 2 remain in full force and effect and have not been modified or amended.

Exhibit 1 Statement of Work

Scope Description

Tiburon will provide the ficense and technical services for the standard E-citation interface to Brazos Technologies. This interface will allow the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office to upload data from Brazos Technologies to Tiburon's Record Management System.

The solution will take the form of reading a fixed length formatted ASCII files provided by the client in a designated location on the Tiburon RMS server, checking for field edits and adding the data to the RMS citation database. Tiburon will provide the file format. There will be an automatic process to continuously scan the designated import folder for files to be uploaded.
