## A RESOLUTION OF FORT BEND COUNTY IN SUPPORT OF THE ROSENBERG RAILROAD MUSEUM

WHEREAS, the Rosenberg Railroad Museum was established in 1990 to emphasize the railroad history in Fort Bend County; and,

whereas, the Museum serves to attract tourism to Fort Bend County and spur redevelopment of the historic downtown; and,
