GENERAL NOTES:

1. Unless otherwise specified in the D data, flags attached to signs are REQUIRED.
2. Top 10 jobs shall be used only on projects that will be at a location for less than two weeks.
3. Existing government markings may remain in place for projects less than two weeks in duration.
4. THE ONE LINE LEFT FOR RIGHT TURN may be used following the RIGHT OR LEFT LANE CLOSED xxxX sign. Indicating distance between signs should be the minimum distance desired.
5. Downstream taper is optional. When used, it should be 100 minimum length per lane.
6. For intermediate term situations, when it is not feasible to remove and replace pavement markings, the channelization must be made compliant by using a very close stocking. This is especially important in locations of conflicting movements where both directions have a maximum allowed travel speed of 10 feet or less as recommended. The 10 foot channelizing device spacing recommendation is intended for the area of conflicting information and not the entire work zone.

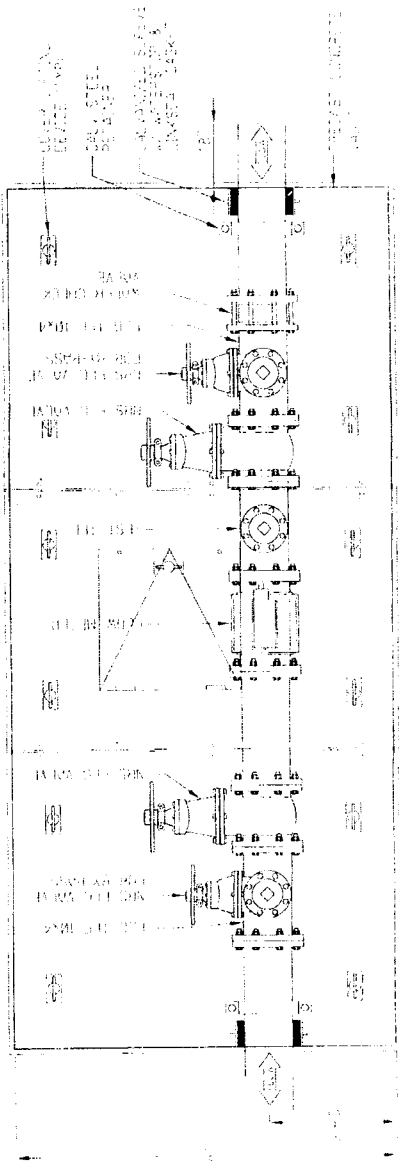

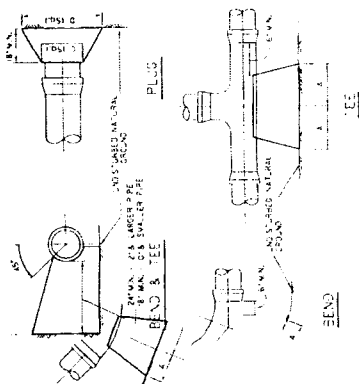

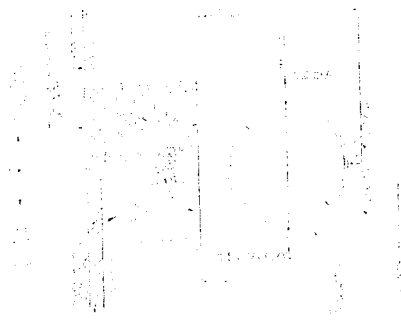
