

**UNITED WAY OF GREATER HOUSTON
SERVICE PROVIDER AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this **1st day of June, 2011** by and between the United Way of Greater Houston and **Fort Bend County**.

PURPOSE: Final disbursement, from the Basic Needs Fund, of the recommendation approved October 17, 2007 revising two previously approved recommendations to fund a portion of the local match required for a multi-year grant period.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Grant funds can be used to provide transportation services to the general public within Fort Bend County and into the Medical Center district of Houston; to help fund additional routes and buses and address other needs identified by the disabled community; to promote the expansion of alternate transportation services in the outlying areas in order to increase accessibility to needed services by people who are disabled, the elderly and those with limited incomes; to help provide new public transportation alternatives that assist individuals with disabilities, including transportation to and from jobs and employment support services.

FUNDING CONTINGENCIES: N/A

TERM: June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2012

COMPENSATION: Funding in the amount of **\$56,309**.

REPORTING: We look forward to hearing about the impact these grant funds have on clients' lives. The mid-term grant report is due after you have expended the first half of your allocation or by January 15, 2012; final report is due after expenditure of the second half of your allocation or by June 15, 2012, whichever comes first. Grant reports will include a beneficiary report identifying the type of assistance provided, the number and demographic characteristics of clients served, two stories that demonstrate the grant's impact and a budget report itemizing the usage of grant funds. 
