

RESOLUTION BY  
FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT IN SUPPORT OF  
THE WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS APPLICATION FOR  
FLOOD PROTECTION PLANNING GRANT ASSISTANCE  
FILED WITH THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, Waller County, Texas, desires to develop a County-wide Flood Protection Planning Study for many of its creeks that drain into the Brazos and San Jacinto Rivers, including Buffalo Bayou, and understanding that some of these areas drain within Fort Bend County;

WHEREAS, Waller County, Texas, ensures that the proposed planning does not duplicate existing projects with the exception of updating existing flood protection plans;


WHEREAS, Waller County, Texas, will appropriate matching funds and in-kind services, if the grant is awarded, to assist with the financing of the Study;

WHEREAS, Waller County will attempt to pursue implementation of viable solutions identified through the proposed planning effort and will pursue and identify potential sources of funding for implementation of viable solutions including working with the City of Katy, Harris County, and Fort Bend County;

WHEREAS, Waller County, as well as many of the other cities of Waller County, Texas, including the City of Katy, Texas, Harris County, and Fort Bend County are currently participating in the National Flood Insurance Program making flood insurance available for all insurable structures in their respective areas.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, supports the application by Waller County to the Texas Water Development Board for flood protection planning grant assistance.
