

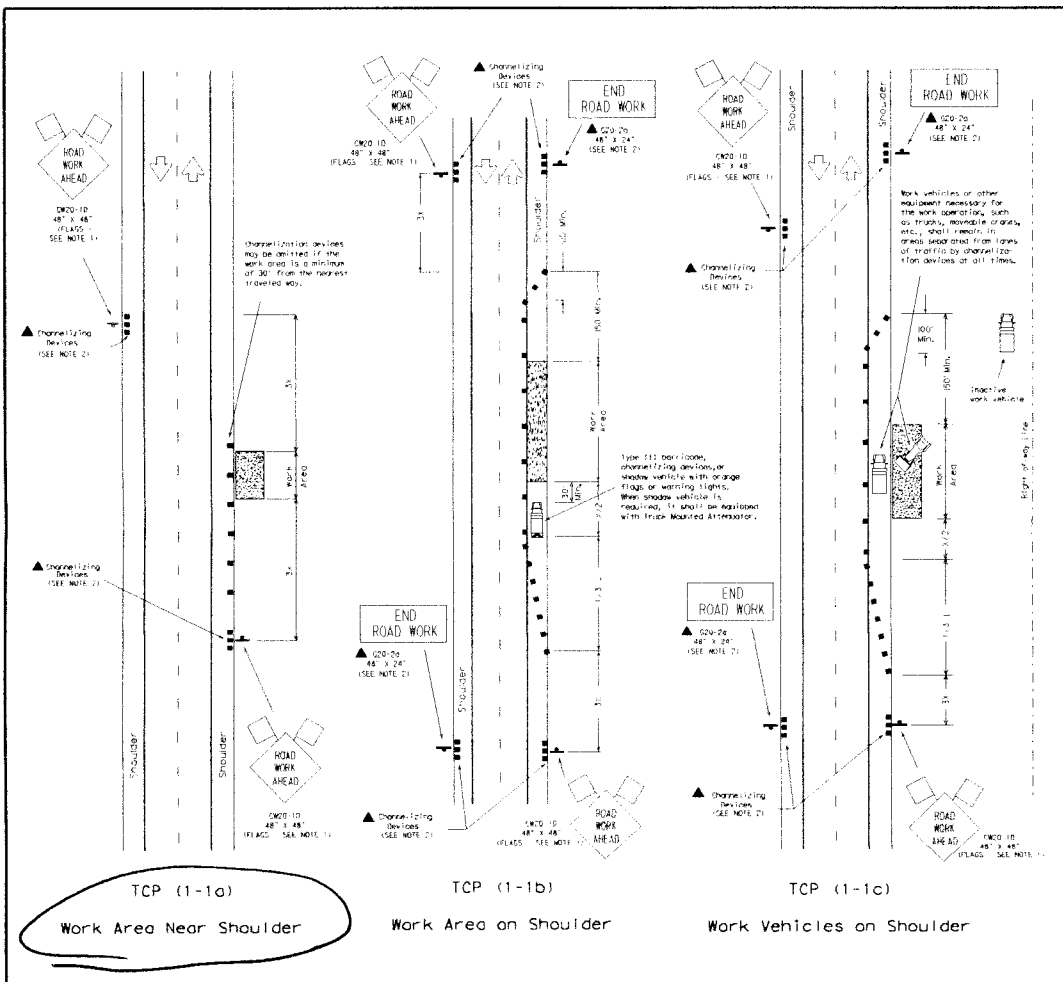

TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

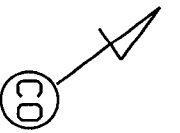
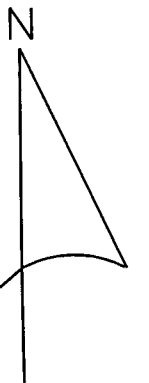
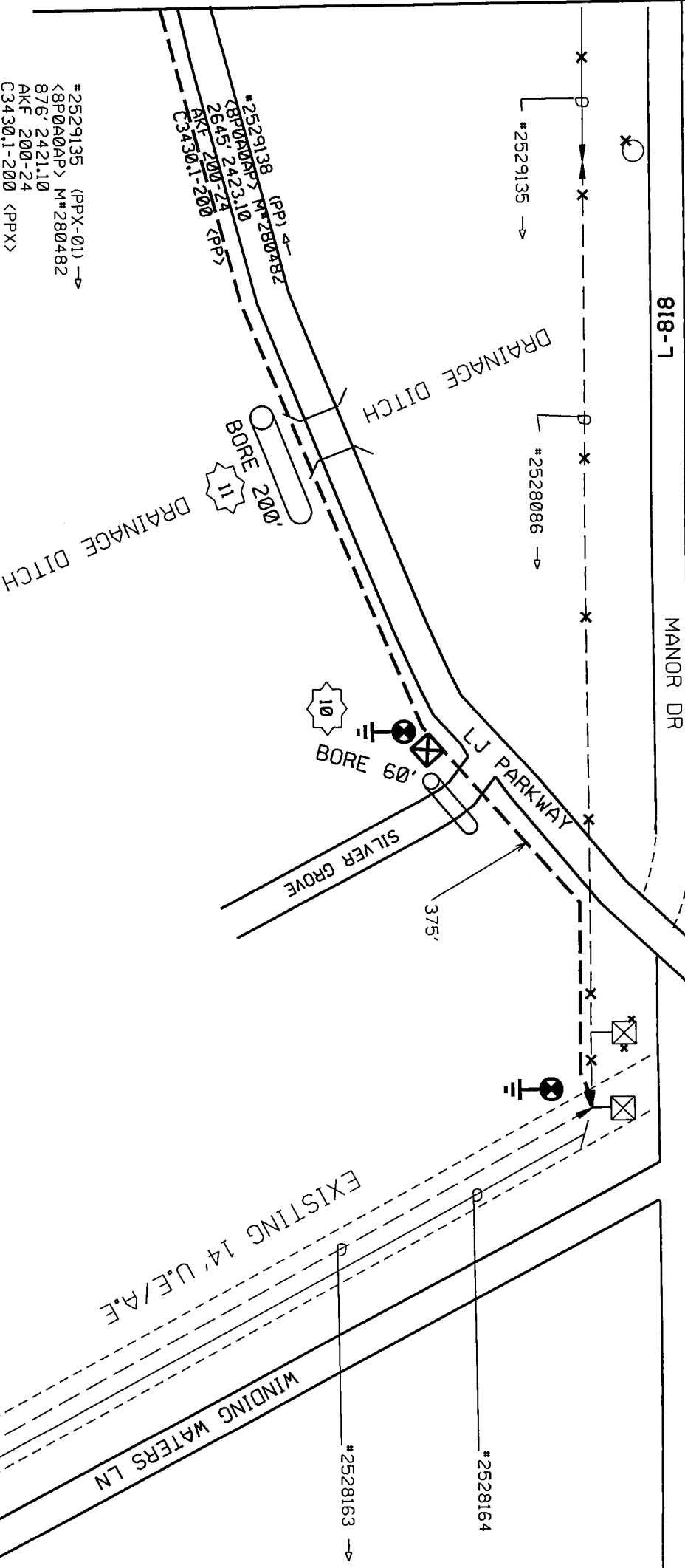
