**THIS AMENDMENT** is made by and between the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, called the "State", and **Fort Bend County**, called the "Transit Provider".

**AGREEMENT**

This amendment incorporates all of the governing provisions of the MGA in effect on the date of final execution of this amendment, unless an exception has been made by the terms of this PGA.


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**3. Signatory Warranty**



## **ATTACHMENT A APPROVED PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

### **DEMAND RESPONSE:**

Fort Bend County will provide shared ride demand response service to residents of Fort Bend County. Transportation services are open to the general public and provide trips within Fort Bend County and into the Houston Medical Center. Reservations can be made up to 30-days in advance or no later than one (1) business day prior to the appointment time. Reservations are accepted between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding Holidays. Rides are scheduled for first drop off by 8 a.m. and last pickup at 5 p.m.

Trip fares are \$1.00 per person each way. This is a curb-to-curb service. However, persons with disabilities can request door to door service.

### **COMMUTER SERVICE:**

Fort Bend County will also provide commuter services known as TREK EXPRESS. Services are offered to the general public via two routes serving the Greenway Plaza and Galleria areas of Houston.

Services start in Sugar Land along the Highway 59 corridor with the first stop at the University of Houston, Sugar Land Park & Ride, and another at the AMC theatre parking lot located at First Colony Mall. The Greenway Plaza route offers connections to the Houston METRO System via a stop at METRO's West Bellfort Park & Ride lot.

Buses leave Sugar Land for Houston on weekdays between the hours of 5:10 a.m. and 8:10 a.m., and return trips from Houston to Sugar Land run between the hours of 3:15 p.m. and 6:40 p.m. Services are not offered on County Holidays.

Cash fares are \$2.25 each way into Greenway Plaza / Galleria and \$1.00 each way to the West Bellfort Park & Ride Lot. Discounted ticket books are also available for purchase.
