**ROUND IV - FUNDING AGREEMENT**  
Dated May 1, 2012

The funding agreement between the Texas Historical Commission and Fort Bend County is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Delete the current Article IV, Section 4.01 and replace it with the following:

*The amount of the grant under this Program that is subject to this Agreement shall be \$296,362. The grant of funds shall be paid to the County in accordance with the procedure described in Article VII hereof.*


- 2. Delete the figures in the Source of Funds Statement and Verification (Attachment A) and replace with:

<i>Texas Historical Commission (state share)</i>	<i>76%</i>	<i>\$ 296,362</i>
<i>Fort Bend County (local share)</i>	<i>24%</i>	<i>\$ 93,588</i>
<i>Revised total project cost</i>	<i>100%</i>	<i>\$ 389,950</i>

All other provisions of this contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The terms of this contract and the amendment thereto are accepted by the parties to the contract. Persons signing are expressly authorized to obligate the parties to the terms of this contract and the amendment thereto.

This Amendment shall become active on the date of the last signature.

Texas Historical Commission (THC) staff has received your Request for Reimbursement Form #7 dated April 9 2012, relating to the planning grant for the historic 1909 Fort Bend County Courthouse.

Request for Reimbursement Form #7 indicates that this is the county's "Final" request and shows a remainder of \$12,632 unclaimed from the grant award. THC staff contacted Fort Bend County's Chief Financial Officer Mr. Jeff Council by telephone on April 24, 2012 to confirm that the county would not be claiming this remainder. Mr. Council responded to THC staff by telephone on April 27, 2012 that he had checked with other county officials overseeing this project and that it is indeed the case that the county will not be claiming the remainder.

To formally close out the planning grant the Funding Agreement will be amended reducing the grant by the \$12,632 remainder. Please sign and return the attached Amendment. The grant funds recaptured will be returned to the Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program grant pool for award to projects in future grant rounds. The balance of your reimbursement requests, currently held as retainage, will be issued on our receipt of the executed amendment.
