
Re: Letter of Agreement

Dear Ms. Shelton:

Central Houston Civic Improvement, a recognized 501(c)(3) organization, is delighted to provide a portion of the local funding share for this important transit study conducted by the Texas Transportation Institute with Fort Bend County as the contracting agent of record. CHCI is funding this work under this Letter of Agreement and will provide up to \$6,800 to cover a portion of the local share. Our 501(c)(3) determination letter is included as Attachment A.

The scope of work is described in Attachment B and is expected to be completed by September 30, 2012. CHCI will provide up to \$6,800 as our share of the local matching funds for the federal grant which will be secured and managed by Fort Bend County.
