**Order of the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas  
Approval of Spending by Certain County & Precinct Officers**

On this day there came to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, the matter of setting expenditures by certain incumbent county or precinct officers who are not renominated or reelected, pursuant to Section 130.908 of the TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. An incumbent county or precinct officer who is not renominated or reelected to the county or precinct office of a county during the time following the date of the official canvass of the primary or election returns are announced shall not make any expenditure in excess of \$5,000 without the advance approval of the Commissioners Court.
2. This order shall be applicable to all expenditures, excluding asset forfeiture funds under Article 59.06 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure and commissary funds under Section 351.0415 of the Texas Local Government Code.
3. This order shall not be applicable to any personnel and/or salary matters, which shall remain subject to established County policies.

This Order shall be effective on June 27, 2012.
