

## **NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE**

The Fort Bend County General Fund conducted public hearings on August 23, 2012 and August 28, 2012 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Fort Bend County General Fund from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 0.41 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.480960 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$192,519,786.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.480760 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$189,961,642.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.480760 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$195,256,243.

The Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County General Fund is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 11, 2012 at Commissioners Courtroom, 7th Floor, Wm. B. Travis Building in Richmond, Texas at 1:00 PM.
