ORDER APPOINTING DIRECTORS FOR
FIRST COLONY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

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WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas ("Commissioners Court"), has heretofore appointed Mr. Scott Jacobson to the Board of Directors of First Colony Levee Improvement District (the "District") to serve for a lawful four-year term of office through February 27, 2011, and has heretofore appointed Mr. Richard Sherrill to the Board of Directors of the District to serve for a lawful four-year term of office through February 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to reappoint Scott Jacobson to serve as Director for the District for the lawful four-year term of office commencing effective February 27, 2011, and expiring on February 27, 2015, or until his successors shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to reappoint Richard Sherrill to serve as Director for the District for the lawful four-year term of office commencing effective February 12, 2012, and expiring on February 12, 2016, or until his successors shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, Richard Sherrill and Scott Jacobson are over twenty-one years of age, resident citizens of the State of Texas, otherwise qualified by law to serve as Directors of the District, and not disqualified from serving as Directors of the District by reason of any law; and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, confers jurisdiction on the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas to appoint the Directors of the District; Now Therefore,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE AND COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct.
