

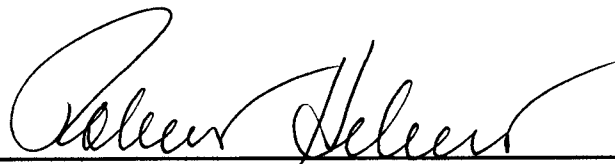

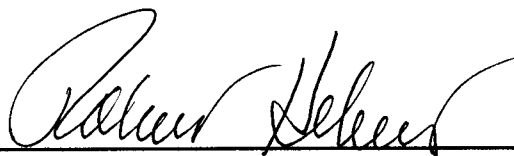

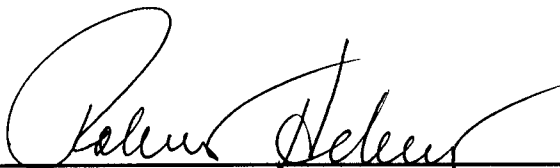

Kaye Reynolds, Deputy Director of Health Dept., discussed developing a care management model that serves patients who currently over utilize the hospital Inpatient and Emergency Room and EMS transport for conditions that could be treated at a community health center.

Ed Sturdivant, County Auditor, discussed how this program would affect the County budget including Federal and State funding.

Commissioner Morrison thanked Dr. Kendrick and all the workgroups for all their time and effort on this program. Agenda item for approval of this program will be on September 25 Commissioners Court meeting.
