| 1). MCA Communications shall install an underground conduit system from the J Long building to the OEM building. The conduit system will comprise of boring and or trenching (2) 4" conduits between the 2 buildings. The system will include placement of 3'x5'x3' deep quazite boxes placed along the route at strategic locations to allow for future expansion and tie ins. |
| 2). MCA shall place a 3'x5'x3' deep twin door lid box at the J Long building to provide underground cable entrance. MCA shall core and install (2) 4" Link Seals for the building entrance. This shall provide leak proof cable entrances. This box can also be used for future cable entrance. |
| 3). MCA Communication shall install (4) 1" innerducts into each of the new 4" HDPE ducts from J Long to OEM. Pull strings included. |
| 4). MCA Communications shall install (1) 144 strand SMF 28 E fiber optic cable from the J Long building and the OEM. MCA shall install a new 4 RU panel in the existing racks at both locations. The cable will be terminated with LC type connectors. All fibers will be tested and documented. |
| 5). MCA Communications shall provide a complete set of engineered drawings for the route. Construction shall not begin until all the drawings have been approved by the City of Richmond, and County of Ft. Bend. The drawings shall be seal by a registered engineer. County of Ft.Bend shall provide all permits and or necessary permit charges. |

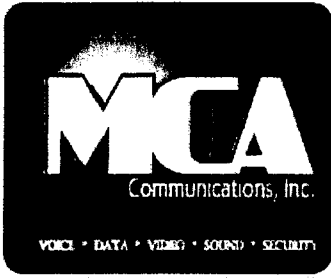

CONTINGENCIES TO REQUEST FOR QUOTE

This proposal is valid for Thirty (30) days from the date shown. After that time, MCA must be contacted to insure that all labor, materials, and construction intervals are still valid.

Normal Business Hours of Operation for MCA employees and/or subcontractors is from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, (except for Holidays which are billed at premium time rates.) Work requested outside of normal business hours may be provided, but will result in additional charges.

The following activities must be completed prior to the start of any work:

a. Notification of Sale to MCA Communications either via Contract Agreement, and/or a Letter of Authorization from the appropriate purchasing manager or Officer of the Company with a valid Purchase Order.



Payment Terms

Unless otherwise stated or written in the Request for Proposal, the following payment terms will be adhered to. Payment will be handled in accordance to Appendix A. Section 7 of DIR Contract No. DIR-SDD-1533. MCA will invoice/charge in the following manner. (Invoice #1) will consist of 100% Material, 25% Labor, shipping and all applicable taxes for the project based on the proposal. (Invoice #2 thru Final Invoice) - will be invoiced/charged on a monthly basis based on the percentage of completion for labor, or, upon completion of project, which ever may come first, including applicable taxes. Change Orders will be billed in the same manner.

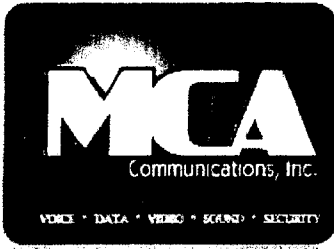
For Projects that utilize an AIA document and/or similar document for invoicing, then the initial payment application (#1) will consist of a 20% Mobilization Fee based on the total contract amount. All progress billings will be invoiced monthly based on the projected percentage of completion for both materials and labor for that month or billing. Unless otherwise noted in the Contract Agreement, 0% retainage will apply for all Material & Labor to include any Stored Materials.

Assumptions/Exceptions for Proposal

Shipping for regular ground (5-7) business days is included at no charge, however, if customer requests expedited delivery services then these fees and/or charges will apply.

Assumptions:

1. The Customer is responsible for providing access to drinking water & restroom facilities on-site during the duration of the project and all associated fees or charges that apply.
2. The Customer will provide the necessary space on-site free-of-charge that is required by MCA for the storage of materials, tools, and equipment to be used in the project.
3. The Customer will provide temporary electrical outlet locations throughout the facilities free-of-charge for the use of power tools & electrical equipment necessary to complete this project.
4. The Customer will provide temporary lighting (if necessary) throughout the facilities free-of-charge so that work can be performed safely and quickly.
5. MCA will conduct daily cleanup of only the debris produced by MCA employees and its subcontractors.
6. MCA will be responsible for firestopping or caulking(if necessary) of all penetrations that we utilize or create, all other penetrations will be the responsibility of the Customer for firestopping or caulking.
