**THIS AMENDMENT** is made by and between the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, called the "State", and **Fort Bend County**, called the "Transit Provider".

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS**, the State and the Transit Provider executed a project grant agreement on **August 8, 2012**; and,

**WHEREAS**, on October 25, 2012 the Texas Transportation Commission approved Minute Order Number **113311** awarding state funds to address specific census impact circumstances; and,

**WHEREAS**, it has become necessary to amend that project grant agreement;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the State and the Transit Provider do agree as follows:

**AGREEMENT**

**1. Description of Amended Items**

This amendment adds the Census Impact award of **\$214,160** to the project grant agreement. The revised maximum amount payable without modification in ARTICLE 3. COMPENSATION is **\$366,866**.

Attachment B, hereto attached, is the revised Project Budget and shall replace the Project Budget page in said agreement.

All other provisions of the original project grant agreement not amended are unchanged and remain in full force and effect. This amendment will become effective on the later date of full execution by both parties.

**2. Incorporation of Master Grant Agreement (MGA) Provisions**

This amendment incorporates all of the governing provisions of the MGA in effect on the date of final execution of this amendment, unless an exception has been made by the terms of this PGA.

**3. Signatory Warranty**

Each signatory warrants that the signatory has necessary authority to execute this agreement on behalf of the entity represented.

The General Appropriations Act enacted by the 82nd Texas Legislature, Regular Session, appropriated funds for public transportation grants for small urban and rural areas of the state. The appropriation also included funds to help mitigate formula allocation impacts when using the 2010 Census. This minute order awards the balance of funds specifically targeted to census impacts.

The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) awarded state funds for FY 2013 in Minute Order 113144 on June 28, 2012. The commission now desires to award the balance of funds as appropriated for census impacts.

The Texas Department of Transportation (department) issued a call for projects on July 12, 2012, to address specific census impact circumstances which were not addressed by the formula awards in June.

The commission desires to award \$2,285,500 for FY 2013.

Transportation Code, Chapter 455 assigns a broad spectrum of public transportation roles and missions to the department.

Transportation Code, Chapter 456 authorizes the commission to administer funds appropriated for public transportation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the commission that the executive director or the director's designee is directed to proceed with the awards as described in Exhibit A, and to enter into the necessary contracts upon completion of all application requirements by the local public transportation operators.
