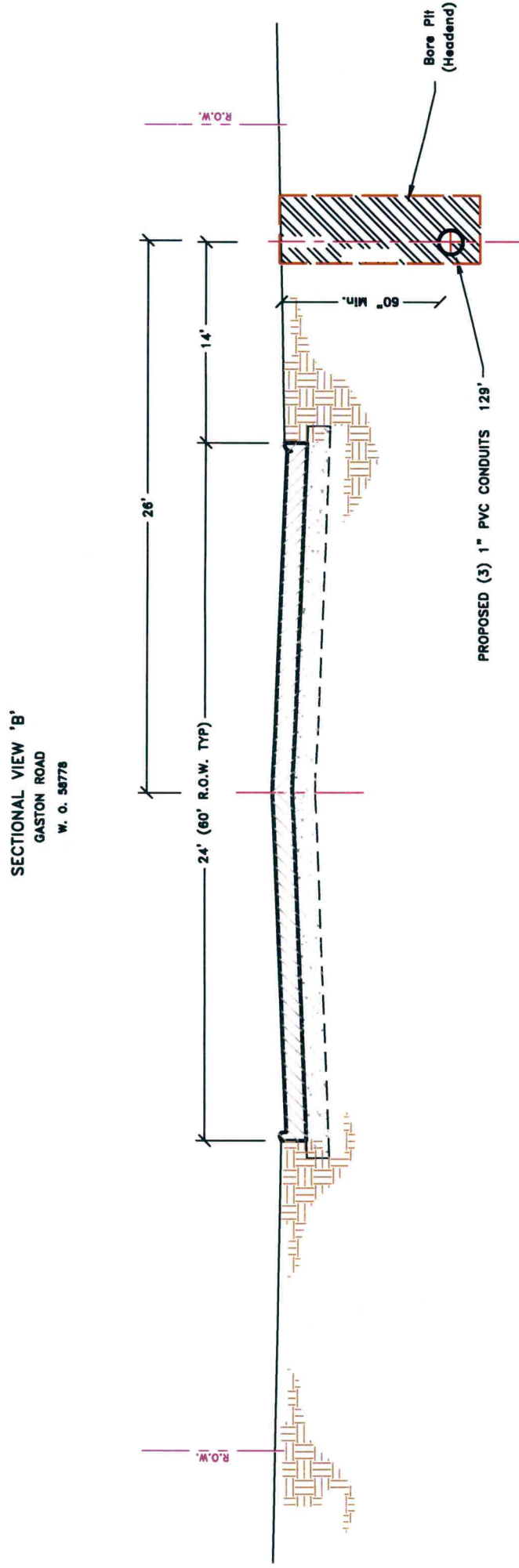
Proposed Underground Wireline Crossing

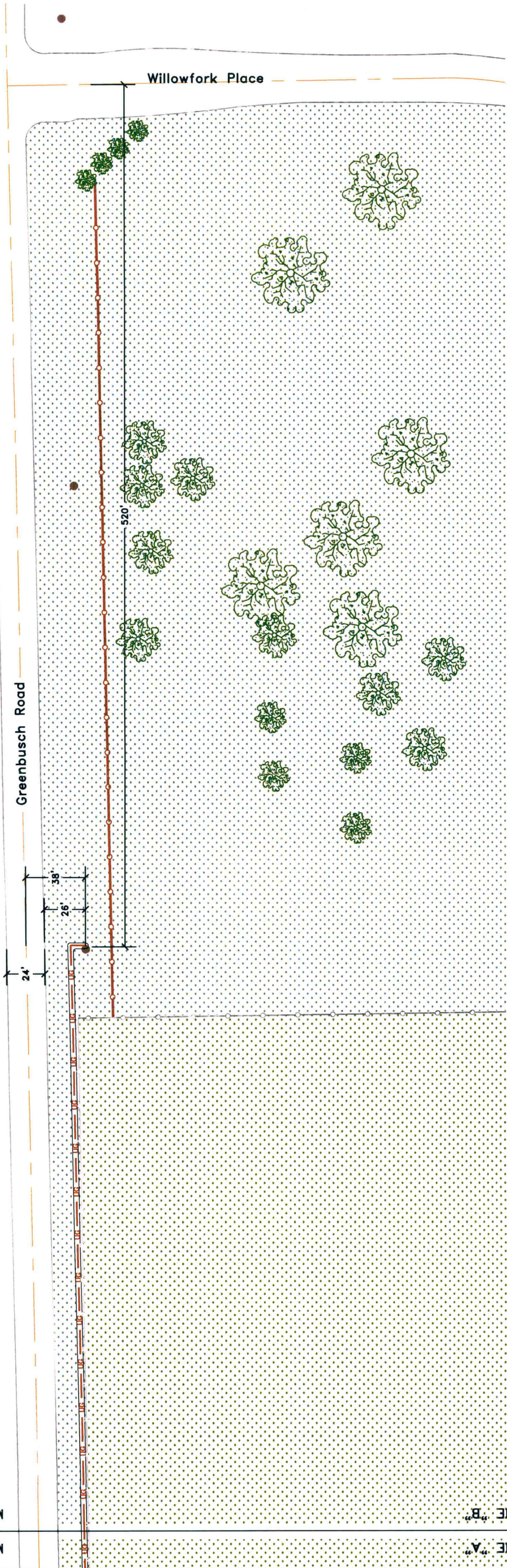
