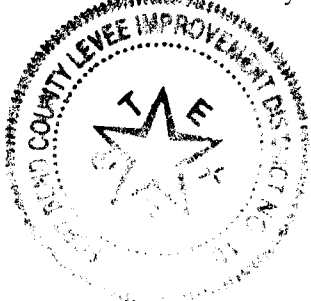

RESOLUTION REQUESTING COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY
TO APPOINT DIRECTOR TO FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT
DISTRICT NO. 10 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, has heretofore appointed Don Burns as a director of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 10 (the "District"), for a term that will expire on January 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, confers jurisdiction on the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas to appoint the directors of the District and to approve the sworn statements and bonds and oaths of office for such directors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District hereby requests that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas re-appoint Don Burns for a new term to expire on January 25, 2017, and approve his sworn statement, bond, and oath of office, which are in proper form and have been properly executed; and

WHEREAS, Don Burns is over twenty-one years of age, is a resident citizen of Fort Bend County, and is otherwise qualified by law to serve as a director of the District, and is not disqualified from serving as a director of the District by reason of any law; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 10 THAT:

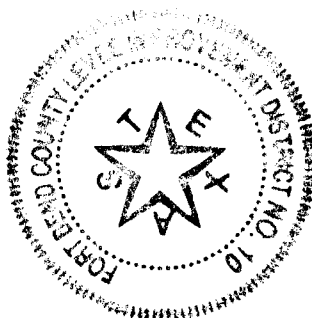

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, has heretofore appointed the Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 10 (the "District"), and approved the bonds and oaths of such Directors; and

WHEREAS, the term of office of Director Burns of the District expires on January 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, desires to reappoint Don Burns to serve as Director for the District for the lawful four-year term of office expiring January 25, 2017, or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, the sworn statement, bond, and oath of office of Don Burns are in proper form, have been properly executed, and are hereby approved by the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Don Burns is over twenty-one years of age, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, otherwise qualified by law to serve as a Director of the District, and not disqualified from serving as a Director of the District by reason of any law; and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, confers jurisdiction on the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas to appoint the Directors of the District and approve their sworn statements and their bonds and oaths; now therefore,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas that:
